Literature Activity:

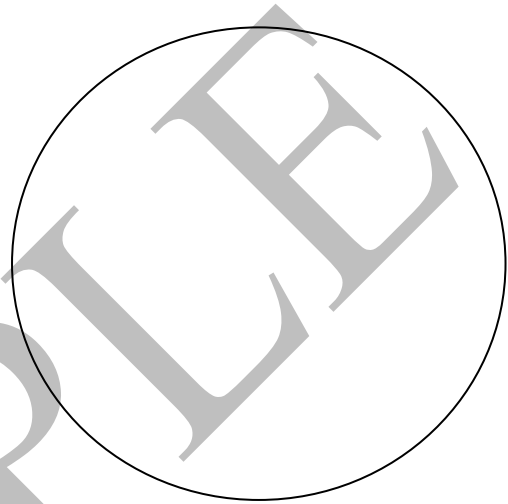
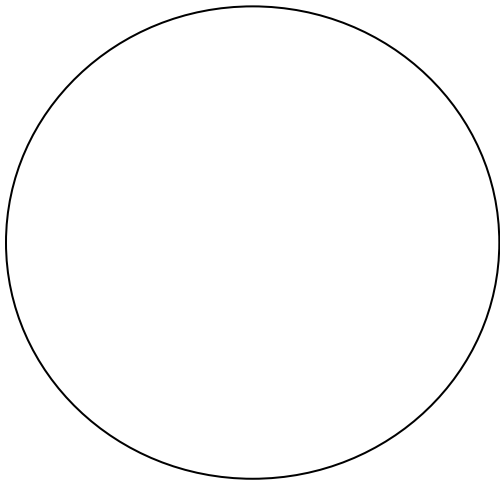
Have your child choose their favorite scene from the story and illustrate it.





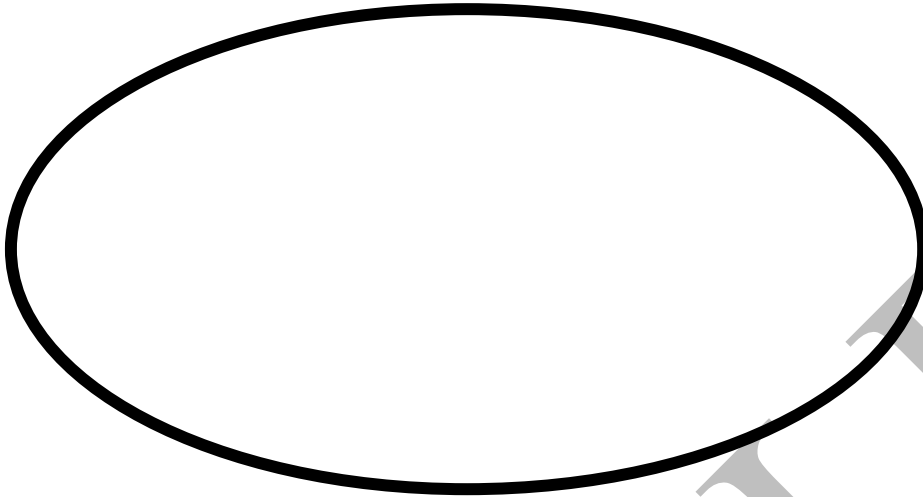
